### Camp Structure

When you pick up your activity schedule on the morning of the first day of camp, you will notice some changes.

- If your 4 or 5 year old is signed up for the 1/2 day program, they will be engaged in three science sessions in the morning.
- We have two outdoor components, one in the morning and one in the afternoon and they are 30 minutes long.
- Parents will have an opportunity to meet their camper's counselor.

Our goal is to strike a balance between academic, social, and recreational pursuits.



### What to Send to Camp

- 2 nut-free snacks, lunch and drinks for each day
- Small water bottle for hydrating during outdoor activities.
- Hat and sunscreen.



### What <sup>not</sup> to Send

**NO CELL PHONES**, iPods, Game Boys, jewelry, cash or other valuables.

### Preferred Camp Apparel

Please dress your camper in comfortable clothing (shorts are best!) and sneakers. 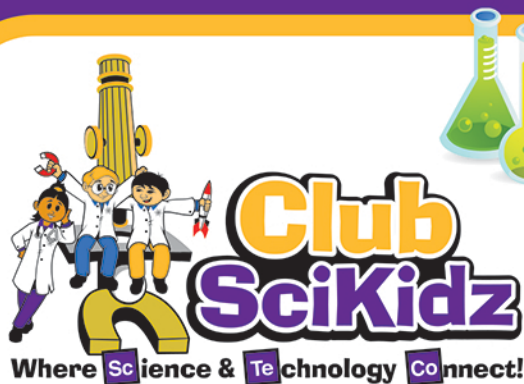

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### Drop-Off & Pick-Up

Regular MORNING Drop-Off is between 8:30-9am. If your camper is attending our Pre-Camp Program, they are to be dropped off at 8am.

Look for **Club SciKidz** signs directing you to the appropriate entrance for your camp facility. Each location will have a registration table for sign-in. Make sure that you receive your unique ID# and pick up a copy of the Activity Schedule for your camper's themed camp.



Please pick up your camper up promptly between 3:30-4pm, unless he or she is attending the Post-Camp Program.



If your camper must leave early, please notify the Camp Director of this in writing!

### Personal Belongings

**Club SciKidz** is NOT responsible for personal belongings brought to camp. Please label all of your camper's items, such as lunch box, water bottle, etc.

Parents must present their camper's unique ID number when picking up their camper. Parents are not permitted beyond the registration desk into the classrooms. We will bring your camper to you for dismissal. If you would like to talk to your camper's counselor, just let us know.



### For Campers:

Inappropriate language will NOT be permitted.

Fighting, teasing, bullying or any intimidation by anyone is strictly prohibited – and is cause for dismissal from camp.

Good sportsmanship is always expected.

Cell phones are not permitted. Campers are not allowed to use them during camp.

Camp t-shirts must be worn each day.

Campers are expected to treat each other, the staff, and the facility with respect.

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### It's all about your camper's **Health and Safety**

In order for our Camp Directors to administer medication to your camper at any time during camp, you and your camper's physician **MUST** complete the "Authorization of Medication" form.

**Medication must be sent to camp.** The medical authorization form, along with several other forms, can be downloaded from our website, in the Your Questions Answered Page.

**If your camper is ill and will not be attending camp, please notify the Club SciKidz main office.**

**Please do NOT send your camper to camp if he/she is not feeling well.**

If your camper becomes ill during camp, we will first call the parent phone numbers. If we can't reach you, we will use the emergency contact numbers you have provided. Please make sure to provide **AT LEAST** three different names and numbers for us to use in case we need to get a hold of you throughout the camp day.

Anytime you are visiting the camp, please have your **camper's ID number** and enter the main entrance of the building.

Remember that parents are NOT permitted beyond the registration table.

**Campers must bring their own lunch, drinks, and 2 snacks each day.** Please do NOT send items that must be heated in the microwave oven. Also, we do NOT have refrigeration at most locations, so a cold pack included in the lunch box is a good idea.

**Due to allergy concerns, please refrain from packing peanut & nut products.**
