

Camp Hours

Monday-Friday 9am-4pm
Regular Drop-off is between 8:30-9:00am
Regular Pick-up is between 3:30-4:00pm
Before Care begins at 8am (\$30/week)
After Care ends at 5:30pm (\$50/week)



What to Bring


- Two nut-free snacks and lunch

Drop-Off & Pick-Up


All drop-offs and pick-ups will be done using a "rolling car loop". Including before, after care and half-day programs. Location specific directions will be shared in the weekly Welcome Email.

Regular morning drop-off is between 8:30-9am. Before care starts at 8am. Regular afternoon pick-up is between 3:30-4:00pm. After care runs until 5:30pm. All campers must be picked up by 5:30pm to avoid being charged a late fee.

General Info

- Each week, an Activity Guide will be sent home with campers. This will tell let you know what campers are doing & learning each day. The curriculum is set-up to follow the schedule, but sometimes things have to be moved around due to weather and other factors.
- For Pre-K campers who are enrolled in the half-day program, pick-up is at 1pm.
- We have two outdoor components each day. There is one in the morning and one in the afternoon, and they are each 30 minutes long.

Health & Wellness

- In order for Camp Directors to administer medication to your camper, the "Medication Authorization Form" **MUST** be completed and signed by a doctor and you.
- Please do **NOT** send your child to camp if he/she is not feeling well. If possible, please notify either the camp director or email: sciencecamps@clubscikidzmd.com if your child will be absent.
- If your child becomes sick or we need to get a hold of you for any reason, we will first call the "parent phone numbers" listed on the registration form. If we cannot reach you, we will use the emergency contact numbers you provided. Please make sure to provide at least three different names and numbers for us to use in case of emergency throughout the camp day.
- The Medication Authorization form and our complete Health & Wellness Policies can be found and downloaded from our webpage.
- Club SciKidz is peanut and nut-free.



Camper Safety



We will be using the PikMyKid app for dismissal and arrival each day. By Monday morning of each week your child is enrolled in camp, your child's name will appear in your PikMyKid app. You will use the app to announce your arrival at pick-up as well as to assign someone else to pick up your child. Each family will still have a security code, but it is automatically integrated into the app. Your child cannot be picked up without someone using the app, and only you control who has access to the app.

Camper Rules & Policies

- Follow directions and be respectful to camp staff.
- Be kind and respectful to fellow campers. Fighting & teasing or any intimidation will not be tolerated and is cause for dismissal from camp.
- Inappropriate language will not be permitted.
- Be respectful of the camp facility and use all materials and equipment safely and properly.
- Good sportsmanship is always expected.
- Cell phones may not be used throughout the day, including at lunch and outdoor activities.
